- Recycle any items that have the recycle symbol

What Can I Recycle?

- ▶ **Glass Bottles / Jars**
- ▶ **Metal Cans**
- ▶ **Plastic Bottles / Jugs**
- ▶ **Catrons**
- ▶ **Paper & Cardboard**

What is the energy saved by recycling?

- **Aluminum Cans** : Uses about 5% of the total energy to recycle than produced.
- **Plastic Bottles** : Uses just over half the amount of energy to recycle
- **Glass Bottles** : 70% less energy to recycle.
- **Paper** : Recycling paper uses 60% less energy
